Our new entrance road 'rules'

We're sure all members would agree that our new entrance road rules... But did you know that the rules are as follows...

40kph from entrance to first hangar
25kph on main road from first hangar
25kph on gravel roads to launch points
15kph between hangars and in vicinity of club buildings
